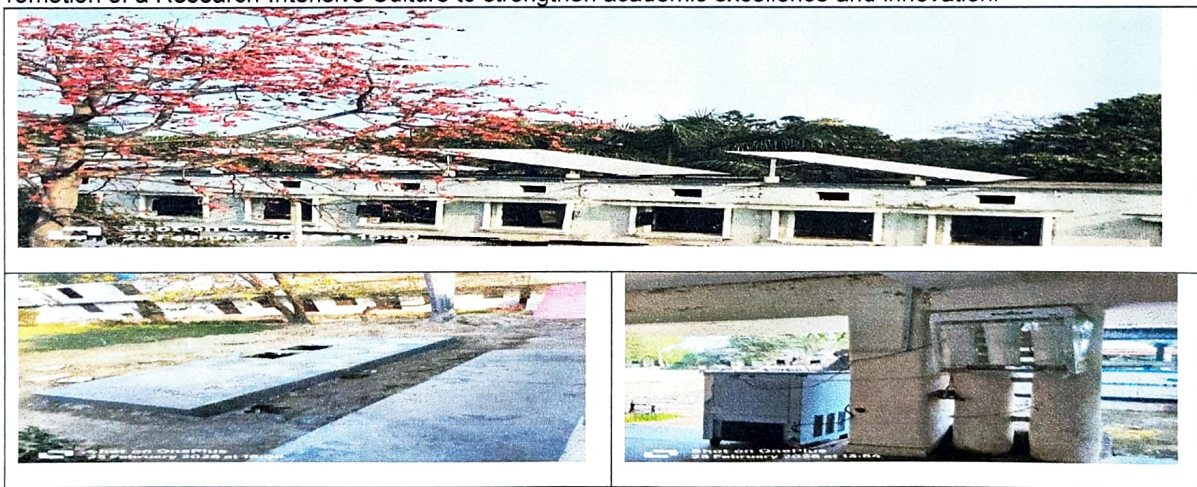
INSTITUTIONAL WEAKNESS: Students from rural backgrounds often face challenges related to soft skills and personality development.
